Another 275 homes are planned for the Mueller development, [according to the Austin American-Statesman](#).

Of those, 58 are planned to sell via the Mueller Affordable Homes program, which aims to sell the homes to those earning 80 percent or less of the region's median income, according to the report.

Six homebuilders are involved in the new-home development, including two new homebuilders – Centerra Homes and Wes Peoples Homes – that have not worked at the Mueller site before. The other homebuilders are David Weekley Homes, Homes by Avi, Muskin Co., [Standard Pacific](#) Homes and Streetman Homes.

There are about 2,500 homes there now and more than 6,000 are planned.
